RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN 2024 EXECUTIVE SUMMERY

The Rural Municipality and Town of Lac du Bonnet are committed to protecting their heritage resources for the benefits of future generations. The Heritage Resources Act (1986) provides authority for municipalities to designate and protect local heritage resources, and to develop initiatives that will encourage, support, educate and promote the management and sustainability of historic resources in the area. The Lac du Bonnet Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee has produced this Heritage Resource Management Plan to identify a number of key goals and objectives for the R.M. and Town's heritage resources for the year 2024.

BACK GROUND

Planning Context

Heritage resource management for the R.M. and Town of Lac du Bonnet is given direction in the following "Historical Resources" section of the Lac du Bonnet Planning District Development Plan.

Section 12.2 The Heritage Resources Act (1985) The primary objective of the District Board with respect to historical resources is to promote the identification of sites and structures that have historical and archaeological significance and to protect them from uses or activities that would endanger their preservation.

Lac du Bonnet Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee (MHAC)

The R.M. of Lac du Bonnet Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee was established in April 1990 by Municipal By-law No. 14-90, so "that the Council may refer to the Committee for its consideration and advice, and the Committee may on its own initiative consider and advise the Council on any matter relating to the powers afforded to the Municipality under the terms of the Heritage Resources Act and, in particular, the Committee may make recommendations to Council respecting the designation of heritage buildings, structures, and lands as Municipal heritage sites, and the demolition, preservation, alteration or renovation of those buildings, structures and lands". On March 28th, 1991 the Town of Lac du Bonnet passed By-law 536/91, officially creating the Town's MHAC. Over time, the membership of the two MHACs has combined into one MHAC, which represents the interests of both the R.M. and the Town.

This year council expressed further confidence in the roll their Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee plays in preserving the heritage of the region. On March 26, 2013 the R.M. Council gave third and final reading to BY-LAW No.36-13 establishing the Lac du Bonnet Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee a "standing committee of council".
